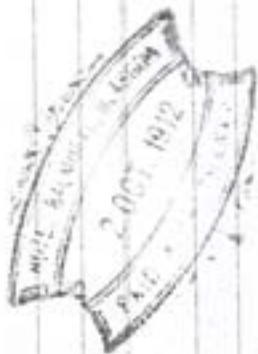

Dear Sir,

I have now received back from the Committee of the Joint Board your application for exemption and the several documents which you formerly sent to me, and I now return them to you, including the two Certificates which you sent me along with your first communication, the Official Certificate of the First Gymnasium, the translation of it, the Syllabus of Work in the Engineering Department of the University of Athens and the translation of that, and the letter of 24th October, 1911 addressed to Mr. A. P. Valentis by Mr. Thom, then Convener of the Joint Board.

The Committee have agreed to grant you exemption for the Preliminary Examination in Science (Engineering) provided that you pass at the Preliminary Examination here in English. English does not appear to be included either in the Gymnasium curriculum nor in that of the Engineering Course in the University of Athens.
